

Stop Selection

- Lighting is recommended for all stop types
- Improvements prioritized by equity and stop utilization
- Constrained Project Timeline
- Bolt-on Approach

- 91 Solar Lighting Assemblies.
- 7 Shelters with Solar Lighting.
- 3 small benches with Solar Lighting Assemblies.
- 8 Real-time Passenger Information Signs.
- Improvements at 103 stop locations












Next Steps
